Parking Lot and Sidewalks

free of large cracks, holes, uneven surfaces and/or dangers clearly identified with contrast paint, a sign or pylon.

well lit

disabled spaces are clear, accessible and have a vertical sign.

Entrances & Exits

Must have one of these:

self-opening doors

disabled push button

doorbell

Entrances have:

clear opening of no less than 81 cm

even surfaces

a ramp 1.5 m wide if stairs present

handrails for ramps and steps ideally on both sides

well lit

doors that allow customers to see someone coming in or out

doors that can be opened easily (door knobs, weight of door)

doors that open and close at a safe speed

glass doors marked at eye level

phone

seating in the entrance/exit

Floors and Aisles

wide enough for walkers, wheelchairs and scooters

access to exits clear

well lit

Stairs (indoor / outdoor)

railings firmly attached

both sides extends beyond top & bottom

well lit

edges marked with a contrasting colour, texture or lights

in good condition

Public Washrooms

wheelchair accessible cubicle 1.5m x 1.5m

cubicle door swings outward

well lit

equipped with grab bars

have a family washroom

Shelves, Racks and Displays

secure & do not move or tip

allow you to move around them easily

items within reach or assistance available

Carts & Baskets

available maintained

easy to manage powershopper provided

Visually Impaired

Signage:

large print

braille

washrooms elevator exit
